Amending the boundary of the parish to include Chandlings Manor school currently in Kennington parish

Impact on district and county council boundaries

Summary of parish council responses

Radley parish council proposed the change. There are issues with sewage outflows from the school that affect properties in Radley parish and the parish council considers that it would be better able to serve its residents if the school was in its area.

Kennington parish council has not responded

Sunningwell parish council objected to a draft proposal from the working group that proposed moving a small part of its parish into Radley. This does not now form part of the recommendation. It put forward an alternative suggestion to transfer the school and the properties at Bayworth into its parish.

Summary of other responses

Recommendation

To move Chandlings Manor school from Kennington parish into Radley parish, as shown on the attached map

Justification

Chandlings Manor sits remote from both Kennington and Radley villages to the west of the A34. The hamlet of Bayworth is in Radley parish and it is this settlement that suffers periodically from the sewage outfalls.

The working group saw merit in the proposal from Sunningwell parish council to move both the school and all the properties at Bayworth into Sunningwell

parish, as the village of Sunningwell lies much closer to these properties than either Kennington or Radley. If this proposal was to gain support from the affected residents during the consultation period, the working group would give serious consideration to including it in its final recommendations. For now, however, it is content to support moving the school into Radley parish to enhance effective representation of local residents at parish level.
