To increase the number of councilors – currently six.

# Impact on district and county council boundaries

## Summary of parish council responses

The parish council requested an increase in parish councillor numbers as a result of the current housing developments and expansion of the village since 2011.

#### Summary of other responses

Five people provided a view on the proposal to change the number of parish councillors in East Hanney. All respondents were in agreement with the proposal.

## Recommendation

To increase the number of parish councillors to eight.

#### Justification

East Hanney had a contested election in 2011 (seven candidates for six vacancies). In 2015 the election was uncontested.

East Hanney's electorate is currently 738 and will increase as a result of housing permissions to approximately 1200 by 2021. The National Association of Local Council guidance is that a council size of seven is appropriate for a council with an electorate up to 900 and eight for an electorate up to 1,400.
