# **Parishes Affected**

East Hanney

## Matter to be considered

To increase the number of councilors – currently six.

## Proposal agreed by the Community Governance and Electoral Issues Committee on 14 August 2017 for consultation

To consult on a draft proposal to increase the number of councillors at East Hanney Parish Council from six to eight.

#### Summary of parish council responses

East Hanney Parish requested an increase in parish councillor numbers as a result of the current housing developments and expansion of the village since 2011.

## Summary of other responses

No further responses were received at this stage of the process. A summary of the responses received to the earlier consultation were submitted to the committee at its meeting in August and showed five people provided a view on the proposal to change the number of parish councillors in East Hanney. All respondents were in agreement with the proposal.

#### Recommendation

To increase the number of parish councillors to eight.

#### Justification

East Hanney had a contested election in 2011 (seven candidates for six vacancies). In 2015 the election was uncontested.

East Hanney's electorate is currently 738 and will increase as a result of housing permissions to approximately 1200 by 2021. The National Association of Local Councils guidance is that a council size of seven is appropriate for a council with an electorate up to 900 and eight for an electorate up to 1,400.
