
Parish Boundary Review

- Have your say ...

You may be aware of the planning application for 700 new houses on the "Land East of Kingston Bagpuize," in a plot of land that is currently in Fyfield & Tubney parish, but will largely affect KBS.

KBS Parish Council has strongly opposed this application, which was initially refused. However, if it ultimately goes ahead, this will mean a huge percentage increase in the local population using KBS's facilities, while not actually living in KBS Parish. In a proactive move, KBS Parish Council is applying to have the Parish boundary moved to include this plot of land. The reasoning behind this is outlined on the Parish Council's website at
