

Forward Plan

1 September to 31 December 2011

What is the forward plan?

The forward plan is a list of the key decisions and other planned Cabinet and Cabinet Member decisions the council intends to take over a four-month period from 1 September 2011. The plan is updated monthly and published at least 14 days before it comes into effect.

What is a key decision?

Key decisions are defined as decisions which, in the view of the relevant Strategic Director, are likely:

- to incur expenditure or make savings which are significant
- to be significant in its effect on communities within more than one ward

Officers may also include other items that do not fit the above definition in the forward plan on a voluntary basis.

What does the forward plan tell me?

The plan gives information about:

- what decisions (key and otherwise) are coming forward in the next four months and beyond
- when those key decisions are likely to be made
- who will make those decisions
- what consultation will be undertaken
- who you can make representations to, and how
- what documents you can ask for
- who you can contact for further information

Who takes key decisions?

Key decisions are taken by the Cabinet, individual Cabinet Members, individual officers or a committee acting under delegated powers. Most key decisions are taken at public meetings.

Who can I contact?

Each entry in the plan indicates the names of all the relevant people to contact about that particular item.

How do I make contact?

The telephone numbers for the relevant officers are listed in the individual entries in the forward plan. The contact details for the Cabinet Members are available on the Council's website www.whitehorsedc.gov.uk or by telephoning the Council offices on 01235 520202.

How do I get copies of agenda papers?
