5	Reasons for Decision	Part 7 of the Localism Act introduced new powers which local authorities can choose to adopt in relation to how they deal with households who are accepted as homeless. Under Part 7 of the Localism Act, local authorities can now choose to discharge the main homeless duty by making an offer of suitable private rented accommodation. Alongside this government has introduced the Suitability of Accommodation Order 2012 which sets out the measures local authorities must take to ensure that this private sector accommodation is suitable.
