6. Report of the Returning Officer on the delivery of the May 2019 district and parish elections

The committee considered the report of the returning officer on the delivery of the May 2019 Vale of White Horse District Council elections and parish council elections for the Vale area and set out a number of action points.

In response to questions, the committee was advised that the delivery of the elections was a priority for the council and there was therefore an expectation that services across the council would provide support. There would have been no impact on the delivery of other council services to customers. The timetable and process for postal vote applications is governed by national legislation. It was therefore not possible to amend a person's choice to vote by postal vote after the statutory deadline to take account of, for example, the non-receipt of a postal vote. However, the returning officer undertook to work with Communications to further improve the publication of deadline dates and anticipated posting dates. Officers would discuss further options for recruiting staff for election duties via social media including LinkedIn.

The committee welcomed the report and agreed that the elections had run smoothly. The committee further endorsed the action points set out in paragraph 31 of the report.

7. Polling district and polling places review

The committee considered the report of the head of legal and democratic on proposals for polling districts and polling places following a periodic review required by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013.

The committee was advised of a late representation from Charney Bassett Parish Council which endorsed the continued use of the Village Hall as a polling place. The committee was further advised of an error in appendix C of the report. The polling place for polling district SAC1 should be the Boundary Park Pavilion and not Harwell Village Hall.

In response to a comment from a committee member officers confirmed that Denman College in Marcham would be considered as an alternative polling place if the designated polling place is unavailable.

The committee noted that the arrangements had worked well in recent elections.
