#### APPENDIX A - BACKGROUND TO THE ENGAGEMENT

The following information is taken from the online survey introduction pages.

As a district council we are responsible for reviewing parish arrangements and implementing any appropriate changes to benefit the decision making and community management in the local area.

In 2014, the Vale of White Horse District Council agreed to create a new parish of Harwell East comprising of the area to the east of the A34 within Harwell parish, up to the boundary with South Oxfordshire.

Having previously agreed to establish a new parish, the next stage in the process is to agree the name of the parish, whether the new parish should have a parish council or an alternative style of council (community, neighbourhood or village); the ordinary year of elections; the council size (number of councillors), and whether the parish should be divided into wards. We are now inviting you to give your views on the following proposals:

- That the new parish be called Harwell East parish.
- That the new parish should have a parish council to be called Harwell East Parish Council.

- That the council should not be warded.

#### Have your say on the proposal to establish a new parish where you live

In 2014, Vale of White Horse District Council agreed to create a new parish called Harwell East comprising of the area to the east of the A34 within Harwell parish up to the boundary with South Oxfordshire.

This area, including around 900 homes in Great Western Park and all of Valley Park lies within the Vale of White Horse. Councillors agreed that residents would be better served by having a separate parish council.

We want to know what you think of the following recommendations that our Community Governance and Electoral Issues Committee has made for the new parish:

- 1. That the new parish be called Harwell East parish.
- 2. To establish a parish council to be called Harwell East Parish Council.
- 3. That the effective date for the new council will be 1 April 2023, with elections for the new council to take place in May 2023.
- 4. That the council should have eight parish councillors.
- 5. That the parish should not be warded.

The report setting out the reason for the proposals and a map of the area are available on our Community Governance Review page, or on request from our Electoral Services Team. In agreeing 'Harwell East' as the name for consultation, the committee recognised that there could well be a more appropriate and locally relevant name. The committee would therefore particularly welcome views on the proposed name of the parish and also on the style of council (currently proposed to be a 'parish' council).



Council size	
As part of the community governance the committee is required to consider the number of councillors for the new parish.	
There are no statutory guidelines on the number of councillors elected apart from a minimum of five. There is a wide variation of council size between parish councils, which appears to be influenced by population. Research by the Aston Business School Parish and Town Councils in England found that the typical parish council representing less than 500 people had between five and eight councillors; those between 501 and 2,500 had six to 12 councillors; and those between 2,501 and 10,000 had nine to 16 councillors. Most parish councils with a population of between 10,001 and 20,000 had between 13 and 27 councillors, while almost all councils representing a population of over 20,000 had between 13 and 31 councillors. Here you can read more about council size.	
The current electorate for the area of Harwell East is approximately 1,400. The Vale of White Horse District Council therefore proposes a council size of eight councillors.

### **Parish warding**

With respect to the question of warding the parish, the committee must consider the following when deciding to recommend that a parish should, or should not, be divided into wards for the purposes of electing councillors:

- whether the number, or distribution, of the local government electors for the parish would make a single election of councillors impracticable or inconvenient.
- whether it is desirable that any area or areas of the parish should be separately represented on the council. For example, this could be the case where in rural areas a parish covers a number of villages and communities.

The Vale of White Horse District Council does not consider that the number and distribution of local government electors would make a single election of councillors impracticable or inconvenient for a single ward, or that the area includes different areas that should be separately represented. For this reason, the Vale of White Horse District Council proposes that the new parish should not be divided into wards, which means that Harwell East would constitute a new, undivided ward.





None of the area is in Harwell village, the A34 separates the communities. It would be much better and honest, to call it Didcot West. The ward, Didcot West is now effectively in central Didcot.
