

ROYAL COUNTY OF BERKSHIRE (FORD LANE, EAST HENDRED)
(PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 1969


The Berkshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, drive, or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle other than a perambulator in either direction on that length of road, specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to use the length of road referred to in that Article for the purpose of obtaining access to or egress from land or premises abutting onto or adjacent to Ford Lane in the Parish of East Hendred, or to enable the vehicle if it cannot be used conveniently for such purpose in any other road or section of road to be used in connection with any building operation or the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of Ford Lane or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1876.
3. The Interpretation Act 1959 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 28th day of July 1969 and may be cited as 'the Royal County of Berkshire (Ford Lane, East Hendred) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 1969.'
