

## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FORD LANE, EAST HENDRED) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 1996

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of the said Schedule 9, hereby order as follows:-

- 1. Save as provided by Article 2 below, no person shall cause any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to proceed in that length of Ford Lane, East Hendred which extends from a point 150 metres south of its juntion with Cat Street for a distance of 22 metres southwards.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause a vehicle to proceed in the length of road mentioned therein if the vehicle is being used:-
  - (a) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) for or in connection with any of the following purposes, and the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road:-
    - (1) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
    - (2) the removal of any obstruction from the said length of road; or
    - (3) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to, the said length of road of any sewer, or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- 3. The Royal County of Berkshire (Ford Lane, East Hendred) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 1969 is hereby revoked.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Ford Lane, East Hendred) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1996, and shall come into operation on 10 June 1996.
