“It’s too early to commit to changing the focus of the Emergency Grant Scheme as we don’t yet know the impact of the shielding programme being paused. We will have a clearer idea in September when we review the Emergency Councillor Covid Grant Scheme, and it’s at that point we’ll be able to make some firm decisions on its future. If a second wave is considered likely or there are local outbreaks, then we may well extend the scheme. If not, then we look into how best to support our communities in recovering from the pandemic as this scheme may not be the best approach to achieving this.”
